And whereas the said Lord Archbishop of Canterbury being on full consideration and enquiry satisfied with such scheme hath certified the same and such consents as aforesaid, by his report to Her Majesty in Council dated the 7th day of January, 1879, which report is in the words and figures following:-

"To the QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

"We the undersigned Archibald Campbell Lord Archbishop of the Province of Canterbury, do hereby report to your Majesty in Council that the Right Reverend Charles John Lord Bishop of | St. Mary who under the provisions of the Incum-

Gloucester and Bristol has represented unto us: (amongst other things) :-

"That to the vicarage and parish church of Westport St. Mary in the county of Wilts and diocese of Gloucester and Bristol belong two ancient parochial chapelries known by the names of Charlton and Brokenborough the limits and boundaries whereof are well known and defined.

"That there is in each of the said chapelries a

church or chapel.

"That the patronage of the said vicarage and parish church of Westport St. Mary belongs to the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain on behalf of Her Majesty the Queen and the Reverend John Ferdinando Collins is the present incumbent of the said vicarage.

"That it appears to the said Lord Bishop that the said chapelries of Charlton and Brokenborough may be advantageously separated from the said vicarage and parish church of Westport St. Mary. and together be constituted a separate parish for ecclesiastical purposes and a perpetual curacy and

"That the said Lord Bishop has drawn up a scheme in writing describing the mode in which it appears to him the proposed alterations may be best effected and how the changes consequent upon such alterations in respect to ecclesiastical jurisdiction dues rates and payments and in respect to patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested which scheme together with the consents thereto in writing of the patron and incumbent of the said benefice of Westport St. Mary and with the consent in writing of the Reverend George Henry Hely Hutchinson the late vicar of the said benefice of Westport
