by Sir George Elvey, was played.

The Bridegroom was conducted to the Right of the Haut Pas, leading  
to the Altar, and His Supporters stood on the Haut Pas, near to His Royal  
Highness.

The Household of His Royal Highness The Bridegroom, and the  
Gentlemen in Waiting upon His Royal Highness' Supporters were shown to  
seats in the Choir by Her Majesty's Gentlemen Ushers.

The Lord Chamberlain and the Vice-Chamberlain then returned to  
receive Her Royal Highness The Bride at the West Entrance to St. George's  
Chapel.

At half-past Twelve o'clock Her Royal Highness the Bride, accompanied  
by Her Supporters, Her Father, His Royal Highness The Prince Frederick  
Charles of Prussia, G.C.B., and His Imperial and Royal Highness the Crown  
Prince of Germany and of Prussia, K.G., and the respective Suites of Their  
Royal Highnesses, proceeded in Carriages from the Queen's Entrance of  
the Castle to the West Entrance of St. George's Chapel, attended by the  
Captain's Escort of the Royal Horse Guards, in the following order:—
