I, JOHN JAMES ROBERT MANNERS, commonly called Lord John Manners, Her Majesty's Postmaster-General, with the approval of the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, given under the hands of two of the said Commissioners whose names are hereunder signed and written, by virtue of the powers vested in me by "The Post Office Act, 1870," and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, do hereby make the following Regulation in alteration of section 19 of the Treasury Regulations of the twenty-sixth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, that is to say:—

1. The second sub-clause of section 19 of the Treasury Regulations of the twenty-sixth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, is hereby repealed, and the following sub-clause is substituted in lieu thereof, that is to say:—

(1.) Circular letters, that is letters which from internal evidence appear to be intended for transmission in identical terms to several persons, and the whole or the greater part of which is produced by means of ordinary type, engraving, lithography, or any other mechanical process.

2. This Regulation shall come into operation on the first day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and on and from that date the 19th section of the Treasury Regulations of the twenty-sixth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, shall be read and construed as if the last preceding sub-clause had been

inserted therein and had formed sub-clause 2 thereof, in lieu of the existing sub-clause 2.
