

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Saint James with Pockthorpe, in the city and county of the city of Norwich, and in the diocese of Norwich, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and forty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and to be receivable in equal half-yearly portions, on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year; and we do also hereby grant and convey to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Saint James with Pockthorpe, Norwich, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all that annual sum or pension of six shillings and eight pence heretofore payable in respect of the said vicarage, and formerly receivable by the Dean and Chapter of Norwich, and recently by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to have and to hold the said annual sum or pension to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient, in our opinion, to produce the said yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and forty pounds, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said vicarage, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, do hereby grant to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Llandygwydd, in the county of Cardigan, and in the diocese of Saint Davids, and to his successors, incumbents of the same vicarage, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and thirty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the fourteenth day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and to be receivable in equal half-yearly portions, on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: And we do also hereby grant and appropriate out of our said common fund to the said vicarage of Llandygwydd, one capital sum of ninety-five pounds sterling, to be applicable towards defraying the cost of executing certain works for the improvement of the parsonage or house of residence belonging to the said vicarage, according to plans and a specification approved or to be approved by us, such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands, at interest after the rate of three pounds per centum per annum, and such interest to be paid to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Llandygwydd: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient,

in our opinion, to produce the said yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and thirty pounds, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said vicarage, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the rectory of Saint Cuthbert, Stella, in the county of Durham, and in the diocese of Durham, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twenty-ninth day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and to be receivable in four equal portions, on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said rectory shall be paid only upon the production to us, on or after each of the said lastly-mentioned days in each and every year of a certificate under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of Durham, that an Assistant-Curate, duly licensed by such Bishop, has been employed within the parish of Saint Cuthbert, Stella aforesaid, during the quarter of the year then ended, and is in receipt of a salary after a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty pounds per annum: Provided also, that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said parish and vicarage of Saint Cuthbert, Stella.
