

of the Maritime Instructions of the 26th of December, 1871,

Yellow Fever having shown itself at certain places in the United States, the Minister of the Interior decrees that ships coming from the United States of America shall henceforth be considered as having a foul bill on account of yellow fever, and shall be subjected on their arrival in the kingdom to the sanitary treatment prescribed by the Ordinance of May 29, 1878, No. 9.

The Prefects of the maritime provinces of the kingdom are charged with the execution of the present Ordinance.
