Helston Union.—Parish of Wendron. To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the

Poor of the Parish of Wendron, in the County of Cornwall :-

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the population of the said parish of Wendron, according to the last census, exceeds two thousand persons;

And whereas at a Meeting of the Vestry of the said parish, held at the Vestry Room, pursuant to public notice in that behalf, on Thursday, the 16th day of October, 1879, a resolution was passed to the effect that the Local Government Board be requested to issue an Order under their Seal of Office, directing that the Act passed on the 5th August, 1850 (13 and 14 Vict., c. 57), entitled "An Act to prevent the holding of Vestry or " other Meetings in Churches, and for regulating " the appointment of Vestry Clerks," should be applied to and put in force within the said parish.

And whereas the Churchwardens of the said parish have made an application in writing to the Local Government Board, pursuant to the above resolution:

Now, therefore, we, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to us by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby order as follows :-

ARTICLE I.—So much of the Act passed in the fourteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty, intituled "An Act to prevent the holding of " Vestry or other Meetings in Churches, and for " regulating the appointment of Vestry Clerks," as relates to the providing of a room or suitable buildings for the purpose of holding Vestry or other Meetings, shall forthwith be applied to and be put in force within the said parish of Wendron,
