

PART 2.—RATES OF POSTAGE to be charged on Letters, Newspapers, Packets of Printed Papers, Patterns or Samples posted in any of the Countries and Places hereunder referred to addressed and conveyed by Post via the United Kingdom to any British Colony or Foreign Country.

Countries and Places.	On each Letter, Newspaper or Packet of Printed Papers, Patterns or Samples, If Prepaid.	On each Letter, Newspaper or Packet of Printed Papers, Patterns or Samples. If the full Postage payable in respect thereof in the Countries and Places referred to in the First Column has not been Prepaid by means of Postage Stamps or Stamped Envelopes valid in the said Countries and Places respectively.
Any country or place comprised in the First Column of Part 1 of Schedule No. 1.	The rate or rates of postage for the time being payable on a prepaid letter of like weight or on a prepaid newspaper or packet of printed papers, patterns or samples of a like weight payable in the United Kingdom in respect of such letter, newspaper or packet of printed papers, patterns or samples of a like weight if the same had been posted in the United Kingdom. Subject in the case of letters to the deduction of the British inland rate or rates for the time being payable.	The like rate or rates of postage less the British inland rate or rates as would have been chargeable and payable under Part 1 of Schedule No. 1 in respect of a letter of like weight or in respect of a prepaid newspaper or packet of printed papers, patterns or samples of a like weight if the same had been addressed to the United Kingdom, in addition to the rate or rates of postage for the time being payable on an unpaid letter of like weight, or on an unpaid newspaper or packet of printed papers, patterns or samples of a like weight, posted in the United Kingdom addressed to such British Colony or Foreign Country.
