WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twentywinth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, and of a certain agreement entered into by us with the Dean and Chapter of Worcester upon the occasion of the renewal of a lease of certain property formerly belonging to the said Dean and Chapter, do hereby, subject as hereinalter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Putney, in the county of Surrey, and in the diocese of Rochester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges (formerly a part of the estates of the said Dean and Chapter), which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us : To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rentcharges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever : Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed, shall be and be taken to be, in lien of and in full substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of forty pounds, heretofore payable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicanage of Putney, in respect of the said tithe rent-charges, to which substitution the Honourable and Reverend Robert Henley, the present Incumbent of the said vicarage, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument : And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the twenty-eighth day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.

In witness whereof, we have hereonto set our common seal, this twenty-fourth day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty.
