Rotherham and Bawtry Railway.

(Alterations in Railways during progress of Bill in Parliament.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that during the progress through the House of Commons of the Bill introduced into Parliament in the present session under the above name or short title, the following alterations have been made in the Railways Nos. 1 and 6, proposed to be authorized by the Bill, namely:—

- (1.) An alteration in Railway No. 1 as shown on the plans relating to the said Bill deposited in the month of November, 1880, with the Clerk of the Peace for the West Riding of the county of York, such alteration commencing in the parish of Maltby, in the said West Riding, by a junction with the said railway at or near seven miles four furlongs and one and a half chains, as shown on the said plans, and terminating in the parish of Stainton, in the said West Riding, by a junction with the same railway, at or near ten miles three furlongs and two and a half chains, as shown on the said plans, and
- (2.)
