

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Bolton-le-Sands, in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Manchester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed, shall be, and be taken to be, in lieu of, and in full substitution for, the yearly sum or stipend of six pounds thirteen shillings and four pence, heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, or by our lessee, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Bolton-le-Sands, in respect of the said and other tithe commutation rent-charges and hereditaments, to which substitution the Reverend Alfred Birley, the present Incumbent of the said vicarage, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
