Cologne, Novemb. 15. There are now twelve Manfer Companies in Garion here; and we expect a Rattalion of Brandenburghers; with Come Troops of Neilibourg which are to continue here the whole Winter. Several Regiments of Brandenburghers are likewife quartered in the Lower Diocffe; and is Companies of Foor, with it Troops of Horfe and Dragoouts, of his Etectoral Higtnefs's Forces, are lodged ar Aixt lis Chapelle. The French Troops, that were encaniped at Echternach neat the Mofelle, are feparated and gone into Quarrers: And thofe commanded by the Marefchal of Durtar, ncar Lamdun, have done the like. The Queen of Spain parted the 13 th inftant from Daletdorp towards Zealand; where her Majelly is to emibark.
Hague, Novemb.18. The Queen of Spaing paffed by Dort on the 16 th intant towards Zealand. The Mceting of the Electors at Ausbourg, for the chufing a King of the Romans, is put off 'till the next month. We hearfrom Namur, that a Party of that Garifon had lately raken eight french Wagon, which were going with Provilions nod Ammunition to Dinant. Prince Waideck is expecied here the beginning of the next week.
Paris, Novernb. 19 . Thy Troops are every where ggne into Winter-quarters; the Marefchal $a^{\prime}$ Himmeres is returnd to $L i f e$; and the Marefchal de Lorge will remain at Metz this Winer. On the 8th inftane we bad the ill News of two of our Egft.India Ships (very richly laden,) being taken by the Dutch: And we are in great pain for another of our Ships, bound home from Suratte: Thefe loffes tall very heavy upon the Eaft India Company here.
