As the Procession passed up the Chapel, Mendelssohn's March, from "Athalie,"  
was played.

The Bridgroom was conducted to the Seat on the Right of the Haut  
Pas, leading to the Altar, and His Supporters stood near to His Royal  
Highness.

The Household of His Royal Highness The Bridgroom, and the  
Gentlemen in Waiting upon His Royal Highness's Supporters were shown  
to seats in the Choir by Her Majesty's Gentlemen Ushers.

Immediately after the departure of The Bridgroom, Her Serene High-  
ness The Bride, accompanied by Her Supporters, Her Father, His Serene  
Highness The Reigning Prince of Waldeck and Pyrmont, and Her Brother-  
in-Law, His Majesty The King of the Netherlands, and the respective Suites  
of Their Serene Highnesses and of His Majesty, proceeded in The Queen's  
Carriages from The Queen's Entrance of the Castle to the West Entrance  
of St. George's Chapel, attended by a Captain's Escort of the 2nd Life  
Guards, Commanded by Major Curzon, in the following order:—
