Flintshire Water and Gas.

(Incorporation of Company; Powers to supply Water and Gas and Electricity in Cilcain, Maesygroes, Trelan, Cefn, Hendrebiffa, Broncoed, Gwernaffield, Gwysaney, Arddynwent, Mold, Llwynegrin, Argoed, Leeswood, Bistre, Buckley, Nerquis, Tryddyn, Soughton, Northop, Caerfallwch, Wepre, Ewloewood, Ewloetown, Pentrobin, Bannel, Broad Lane, Hawarden, Moor, Manor and Rake, Broughton, Bretton, Aston, Mancot, Shotton, Saltney, Higher Kinnerton, Estyn, Hope Owen, Shordley, Hartsheath, Rhanberfedd, Caergwrle, Uwch-y-mynydd-isaf, Cymmau, all in the county of Flint, and Llanferres, otherwise Llanferras, in the county of Denbigh; Construction of Waterworks and Gas Works; Diversion of Waters; Compulsory Purchase of Lands and Water Rights; Manufacture and Storage of Gas and Residual Products; Powers to manufacture and provide Stoves, Engines, Cooking, Heating, and other Machinery and Appliances, and to acquire Patent Rights; Agreements with Local Board of Mold and Mold Gas and Water Company and other Authorities, Companies, and Persons, and Powers to them to apply and raise Moneys; Other Powers; Amendment or Repeal of Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing session for leave to bring in a Bill for all or some of the following among other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To incorporate a company (hereinafter called "the Company") and to confer upon the Company all necessary powers to enable them to execute the works and carry into effect the objects following, or some of them (that is to say):—

2. To supply with water and gas for public and private purposes the whole or any part of all or some of the parishes, townships, and places following, viz.:—Cilcain, Maesygroes, Trelan, Cefn, Hendrebiffa, Broncoed, Gwernaffield, Gwysaney, Arddynwent, Mold, Llwynegrin, Argoed, Leeswood, Bistre, Buckley, Nerquis, Tryddyn, Soughton, Northop, Caerfallwch, Wepre, Ewloewood, Ewloetown, Pentrobin, Bannel, Broad Lane, Hawarden, Moor, Manor and Rake, Broughton, Bretton, Aston, Mancot, Shotton, Saltney, Higher Kinnerton, Hope Owen, Estyn, Shordley, Hartsheath, Rhanberfedd, Caergwrle, Uwch-y-mynydd-isaf, Cymmau, all in the county of Flint, and Llanferres, otherwise Llanferras, in the county of Denbigh.

3. To make and maintain the waterworks and other works and conveniences following, or some of them (that is to say):—

A reservoir (No. 1) to be situate in the parishes of Cilcain, in the county of Flint, and Llanferres, otherwise Llanferras, in the county of Denbigh, near the farmhouse known as Brith-dir-Mawr, and at or near the point where two streams from Moel Famma unite and form one stream (one of which streams is called or known as Cwm Llydan, and forms a portion of the boundary between the counties of Denbigh and Flint), and to be formed by an embankment or dam across the said stream at a point in the centre of the stream 1 mile 10 chains or thereabouts, measured in a straight line from and to the eastward of the Jubilee Tower on Moel Famma. The said embankment or dam will commence in the said parish of Cilcain, at a distance of

6½ chains or thereabouts from and to the north-eastward of the point above described, in the centre of the said stream, and 6½ chains or thereabouts from and to the southward of the south-eastern corner of the farm buildings known as Brith-dir-Mawr, and will extend across the said stream in a south-westerly direction, and terminate in the said parish of Llanferres, otherwise Llanferras, at a point 8½ chains or thereabouts from its commencement as above described.

The said Reservoir No. 1 will commence at the said embankment or dam, and will extend up the said two streams for a distance of 11 chains or thereabouts, measured in a straight line from and to the westward of the centre of the said intended embankment or dam.

A service reservoir (No. 2) to be situate at Prenbrigog, in the township of Argoed, in the parish of Mold, in the county of Flint, in the field No. 325 on the 25-inch Ordnance map of the said parish of Mold, and 1 chain or thereabouts, from and to the westward of the farm buildings of Prenbrigog Farm.

An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes (No. 1) wholly in the said parish of Llanferres, otherwise Llanferras, commencing from and out of the said intended Reservoir No. 1, on the south side thereof, at a point 1 chain or thereabouts, westward of the said intended embankment or dam, thence running in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 26 chains or thereabouts, and terminating in a stream at a point 29 chains or thereabouts from and to the west of the farmhouse known as Cwm-bach.

An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes (No. 2) commencing in the township of Maesygroes, in the said parish of Cilcain, from and out of the intended Reservoir No. 1, at or near the said intended embankment or dam, and terminating in the said intended service Reservoir No. 2.

An aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes (No. 3) commencing from and out of the intended service Reservoir No. 2, and terminating in the township of Hawarden, in the parish of Hawarden, in the county of Flint, in the existing reservoir situate at Truemans Hill; which intended reservoirs, embankment, or dam, aqueducts, conduits, or lines of pipes will be made, or pass from, in, through, or into the several parishes, townships, extra-parochial and other places following, or some of them (that is to say):—Cilcain, Maesygroes, Hendrebiffa, Broncoed, Arddynwent, Mold, Bistre, Buckley, Argoed, Ewloewood, Ewloetown, Aston, and Hawarden, all in the county of Flint, and Llanferres, otherwise Llanferras, in the county of Denbigh.

4. To make and maintain in the parishes, townships, and places aforesaid, or any or either of them, and in connection with the intended reservoirs and waterworks, or any of them, all necessary and proper embankments, walls, filtering beds, dams, drains, sluices, residuum lodges, catchpits, conduits, culverts, channels, bye-washes, weirs, wells, tanks, engines, pipes, buildings, machinery, roads, approaches, and other works and conveniences connected therewith or incidental thereto.

5. To take, collect, divert, impound, and use all or some of the waters of the said streams hereinbefore mentioned or referred to, and of all their tributary streams and springs at and above the points at which the same respectively are
