

part or parts thereof, and the employment of officers and servants.

21. To authorise and empower the Company to sell and convey, or to demise and lease their undertaking, docks, wharves, railway, roads, lands (including superfluous lands), property and effects, rights, powers, authorities, and privileges, including power to demand, take, and recover tolls, rates, rents, dues, duties, and charges, to execute and maintain works, and to purchase lands, compulsorily or otherwise (all which are hereinafter collectively referred to as and included in the expression "the Company's undertaking") or some part or parts thereof to the Alexandra (Newport and South Wales) Docks and Railway Company (hereinafter called the "Alexandra Company"), or to vest the Company's undertaking or some part or parts thereof, in and amalgamate the same with the undertaking of the Alexandra Company upon such terms (pecuniary and otherwise) and under and subject to such conditions, exceptions, and limitations, if any, and in the case of a lease for such period or periods as shall have been or may be agreed upon between the Company and the Alexandra Company, or as shall or may be prescribed in or provided for by the intended Act, and to empower the Alexandra Company to accept a transfer or lease of the undertaking of the Company, or some part or parts thereof respectively, and to have and exercise all or some of the rights, powers, authorities, and privileges aforesaid, of the Company in connection with the premises sold, demised, vested, or amalgamated.

22. To authorise and empower the Company and the Alexandra Company, to enter into and carry into effect agreements with respect to all or any of the matters aforesaid, and to confirm, sanction, and give effect to any such agreements, or to any lease which have or has been, or may be made or entered into between the said Companies with reference thereto.

23. To vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would interfere with the objects of the intended Bill, or such contracts, agreements, or arrangements aforesaid, and to confer other rights and privileges.

24. And it is intended, so far as may be requisite or desirable, for any of the purposes of the Bill, to amend or repeal the provisions or some of the provisions, of the several local and personal Acts of Parliament following, or some of them, that is to say: 5 and 6 Wm. 4, cap. 75; 2 and 3 Vic., cap. 74; 4 and 5 Vic., cap. 51; 7 and 8 Vic., cap. 78; 17 and 18 Vic. cap. 185; and all or any other Act or Acts relating to the Company; 28 and 29 Vic., cap. 377; 31 and 32 Vic., cap. 57; 33 and 34 Vic., cap. 161; 36 and 37 Vic., cap. 151; 37 and 38 Vic., cap. 90; the private Act, 41 and 42 Vic., cap. 5; the Alexandra (Newport and South Wales) Docks and Railway Act, 1882, and all or any other Act or Acts relating to the Alexandra Company; 5 and 6 Wm. 4, cap. 107; and all or any other Act or Acts relating to the Great Western Railway Company.

25. And notice is hereby also given, that on or before the 30th day of November instant, plans and sections of the works proposed to be authorised by the Bill, the plans showing also the lands intended to be purchased or taken for the purposes thereof, and plans of the additional lands to be purchased compulsorily under the powers of the Bill, and of the lands, the reversion or any interest in which is to be so purchased, with a book of reference to such plans respectively, and a copy of this notice, as pub-

lished in the London Gazette, will be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the county of Monmouth, at his office at Usk, in that county, and with the parish clerk of the parish of Saint Woollos, at his residence.

Printed copies of the intended Bill will be deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 21st day of December next.

Stone Water.

(Application to the Board of Trade for power to construct waterworks, and to supply water within the district of the Stone Local Board, in the county of Stafford.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade on or before the 23rd day of December next, for a Provisional Order pursuant to the Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870, for authority to construct and maintain waterworks and works connected therewith, and to supply water to and within the district of the Stone Local Board, in the county of Stafford.

The intended Order will confer upon a Company to be formed for the purpose, or upon the persons to be named therein (hereinafter called the promoters), power to make and maintain the following works, with all necessary approaches, fences, excavations, embankments, sluices, pipes, conduits, standpipes, culverts, channels, tunnels, adits, levels, dams, weirs, outfalls, valves, wells, shafts, drifts, tanks, pumps, drains, filters, filter-beds, embankments, cuttings, and other conveniences and appliances connected therewith respectively (that is to say):—

1. A well shaft or boring (No. 1), to be situate in and at the south-west of a field called Idle-rocks, numbered 1,840 on the Ordnance 25-inch map, in the parish of Stone.

2. A well shaft or boring (No. 2), to be situate in a field, called Moddershall Oaks, numbered 950 on the Ordnance 25-inch map, at a distance of 120 yards, or thereabouts, westward of the well shaft or boring (No. 1), in the parish of Stone.

3. A well shaft or boring (No. 3), to be situate in or near the western end of the same field, called Moddershall Oaks, in the same parish.

4. A well shaft or boring (No. 4), to be situate in the field, numbered 1,822 on the 25-inch Ordnance map, in the parish of Stone, at a point 330 yards, or thereabouts, north of the "Wild Boar" public-house.

5. A reservoir, to be situated partly in the field numbered 1,887, and partly in the field numbered 1,895 on the Ordnance 25-inch map, in the parish of Stone, which fields belong, or are reputed to belong, to Sir Lionel Pilkington.

6. A conduit, aqueduct, or line or lines of pipes (No. 1), wholly in the parish of Stone, commencing from and out of the well shaft or boring (No. 1) before described, passing thence in a south-westerly direction to and terminating at the reservoir fifthly above described.

7. A conduit, aqueduct, or line or lines of pipes (No. 2), wholly in the parish of Stone, commencing from and out of the well shaft or boring (No. 2), before described, and terminating by a junction with the conduit, aqueduct, or line of pipes (No. 1), in the field numbered 1,831, on the Ordnance 25-inch map, at a point distant 350 yards, or thereabouts, north-eastward of the "Wild Boar" public-house.
