and terminating in Icknield-street at a point $.0 \cdot 45$ chain sonth of Pitsford-street.

Tramway No. 19 will be a single line of bramway for its whole length.

Tramway (No. 20) commencing in Monumentroad, by a junction with Tramway No. 12, at a point 0.90 chain south of Spring Hill, passing in a northerly direction along Icknield-street. and Hunter's-lane, and terminating therein at a point in the centre of the bridge over Hockley Brook.

Tramway No. 20 will be a single line of tramway, except at the following places, where it will be a double line:-In Icknield-street, from a point 0.70 chain south of Hingeston-street for a distance of 3 chains to the north, and from a: point 0.18 chain north of Pitsford-street for a distance of 6 chains to the north, and also from a point 1.20 chain north of the north-western corner of the General Cemetery for a distance of 3 chains to the north, and also from a point 0.80 chain south of the entrance to dwelling-house No. 313 in Icknield-street for a distance of 3 chains to the north.

Church Hill, Hamsteadroad from a point $1 \cdot 30$ chain north of Church Hill-road for a distance of $2 \cdot 60$ chains to the north; also from a point 0.20 chain south-east of the garden entrance to the Limes Villa for a distance of 3 chains to the north-west; in Handsworth Wood-road from a point 0.30 chain north of Wellington-road for a distance of $2 \cdot 60$ chains to the north; also from a point 2 chains sonth-east of the south-eastern corner of the Policeman's Cottage for a distance of 3 chains to the north-west; also from a point $2 \cdot 20$ chains north-west of World's End-road, for a distance of 2.60 chains to the north-west; also from a point $2 \cdot 20$ chains south-east of the entrance to Hamstead Hill School for a distance of 3 chains to the north-west.
Tramway (No. 22) commencing in Hamsteadroad by a junction with Tramway No. 21 at a point 0.45 chain sonth of Church Hill-road, and passing in an easterly direction along Charch Hill-road and Heathfield-road, and terminating therein at a point 0.30 chain west of Birchfieldroad.

Tramway No. 22 will be a single line of tram-
way, except at the following places, where it will be a donble line line :-In Church Hill-road from point 0.90 chain east of Church Vale for a distance of 3 chains to the east; from a point 1.40 chain east of Charles-road for a distance of 3 chains to the east; from a point 0.80 chain east of Crompton-road for a distance of 3 chains to the east; in the Heathfield-road from a point 1. chain east of New Inns-road for a distance of $2 \cdot 60$ chains to the east.
Tramway (No. 22a) commencing in Church Hill-road by a junction with Tramway No. 22, at a point 0.15 chain west of Westminster-road, thence curving into and terminating in Heath-field-road at a point 2.85 chains north of Leonardsroad by a junction, with Tramway No. 23.

Tramway No. 22a will be a single line of tramway for its whole length.
Tramway (No. 23) commencing in Heathfieldroad at its intersection with Church Hill-road by a junction with Tramway No. 22 at a point 0.75 chain west of Wilson-road, and passing in a south-westerly direction along Heathfield-road and Barker-street, and terminating in Hunter'slane by a junction with Tramway No. 21 at the intersection of Barker-street with Hunter'slane.

Tramway No. 23 will be a single line of tramway except at the following places, where it will be a double line:-In Heathfield - road at a point 0.70 chain south-west of the commencement of the tramway for a distance of 3 chains to the sonth-west; from a point 0.15 chain south-west of Upper Crompton-road for a distance of 2.60 chains to the south-west; from a point 2.70 chains north-east of the centre of cottage No. 70 for a distance of $2 \cdot 60$ chains to the south-west; from a point 1.30 chain north-east of the western corner of the Villa Cross Inn for a distance of 2.60 chains to the soath-west.

Tramway (No. 24) commencing in Alcesterroad, Moseley, by a junction with the authorised Traniway. (No. 3) (Southern Division) of the Birmingham and Suburban Tramways Order, 1882, at a point 2.90 chains south of the northwest corner of the Fighting Cocks Inn, thence passing in a south-westerly direction along Alcester-road and terminating therein at a point $3 \cdot 30$ chains south of Vicarage-road.

Tramway No. 24 will be a single line of tramway, except at the following places, where it will be a double line:-In Alcester-road, from the commencement of the tramway for a distance of 3 chains to the south-west; from a point opposite the garden entrance to the Larches Villa for a distance of 3 chains to the south-west; from a point 0.75 chain.north of the lamp-post at the junction of Moor-green-lane with Alcester-road for a distance of 4 chains to the sonth; from a point 5 chains north of the centre of the bridge carrying the Alcester-road over the Midland Railway for a distance of 3 chains to the south-west; from a point opposite the north-west corner of Retreat Cottage for a distance of 3 chains to the southwest; from a pointil 140 chain south of the southeast corner of Kings Heath Chapel for a distance of 3 chains to the south.
Tramway (No. 24a) commencing in Alcester: road, by a junction with Tramway No. 24 at a point 0.38 chain north of and passing into Vicarage-road and terminating therein at a point 3.50 chains from. its commencement.
Tramway No. $24 a$ will be a single line of tramway for its whole length.
Tramway (No. 24b) commencing in the
