- Alfred Roberts, Esq., Honorary Secretary and Consulting Surgeon to Prince Alfred Hospital, Sydney, New South Wales.

THE Queen has been pleased to give and grant unto Major-General Sir Frederick John Goldsmid, K.C.S.I., C.B., Her Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Insignia of the Second Class of the Order of the Osmanieh, which His Highness the Khedive of Egypt, authorized by His Imperial Majesty the Sultan, has been pleased to confer upon him, in approbation of his services while actually and entirely employed by His Highness beyond Her Majesty's dominions.

Whereas We did, by Warrant under Our Royal Sign Manual, bearing date the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, and by subsequent Warrants, authorize and appoint certain noblemen and gentlemen therein respectively named, or any three or more of them, to be Our Commissioners, to make inquiry into the places in which documents, illustrative of history or of general public interest, belonging to private persons are deposited, and to consider whether, with the consent of the owners, means might not be taken to render such documents available for public reference, as by the tenor of the first-recited Warrant under Our Sign Manual, dated the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, does more fully and at large appear:

Now know ye, that We have revoked and determined, and do by these presents revoke and determine, the said several Warrants, and every matter and thing therein contained.

And whereas We have deemed it expedient that a new Commission should issue for the purposes specified in such Warrant dated the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine:

Further know ye that We reposing great trust and confidence in your ability and discretion, have appointed, and do by these presents, nominate, constitute, and appoint you the said Sir William Baliol Brett; Chichester Samuel, Baron Carlingford; Schomberg Henry, Marquess of Lothian; Robert Arthur Talbot, Marquess of Salisbury; John Alexander, Marquess of Bath; Archibald Philip, Earl of Rosebery; Henry Howard Molyneux, Earl of Carnarvon; Edward George Petty FitzMaurice; Charles, Bishop of Limerick, Ard-
