NOTICE is hereby given, that the above-named Insolvent, being a Trader within the meaning of the Bankrupt Laws, did, on the 16th instant, file a petition in this Honourable Court, praying that he might be discharged from all the liabilities in respect of debts or claims established, or which might by law be proved in Court in the matter of his Insolvency; and that the Court, on the said 16th instant, made an order nisi for his discharge in the nature of a certificate; and that the said Court appointed the 3rd Wednesday in September next for the further hearing of the matters of the said Insolvent's Petition. Any creditor wishing to dissent from the said insolvent having his discharge, must give notice in writing thereof to me, at my office, at least three clear days before the hearing, and all creditors who shall not have given such notice shall, at the expiration of the aforesaid period, be taken to have assented thereto.
