Clacton-on-Sea Gas and Water.

(Application to the Board of Trade under "The Gas and Waterworks Facilities Act, 1870," for Power to raise Additional Capital; and for other purposes.)

NOTICE is hereby given that "The Clacton-on-Sea Gas and Water Company, Limited," (hereinafter called "the Company") intend to apply to the Board of Trade, on or before the 23rd day of December next, for a Provisional Order under "The Gas and Waterworks Facilities Act, 1870," to be subsequently confirmed by Act of Parliament in the ensuing Session for all or some of the following purposes, that is to say:—
To authorise the Company—

1. To raise additional capital for the purposes of their several undertakings, by the creation and issue of new, ordinary, or preference shares or stock, and by borrowing on mortgage or otherwise, and by the creation and issue of debenture stock, or by all or some of such means.

2. To incorporate all or some of the provisions of the Companies Clauses Acts, 1845, 1863, and 1869, the Lands Clauses Acts, and the Gasworks Clauses Act, 1871, and so far as may be necessary for the purposes of the Order, to repeal or amend and enlarge the provisions of "The Clacton-on-Sea Gas and Water Order, 1876," to confer on the Company all necessary powers for the better carrying into effect the objects and purposes of the Company; to vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would in any way impede or interfere with such objects and purposes, and to confer other rights and privileges.

3. To provide, fit up, sell, or let on hire, gas tubes, meters, pipes, fittings, burners, chandeliers, cooking and other stoves, engines, machines for the production of motive power for domestic, agricultural, manufacturing, and other purposes by means of gas, and all other articles, apparatus, and things in any way connected with gasworks or with the supply of gas, or necessary for and incidental to any of the purposes to which gas is applicable.

4. To authorise the Company to acquire and hold patent rights and licences in relation to the manufacture or distribution of gas and the utilization of the residual products obtainable therefrom, or the production by any means of artificial light (except electricity).

And notice is hereby further given, that on or before the 29th day of November instant a copy of this Notice as published in the London Gazette, with a map showing the land used for the manufacture of gas or of residual products arising in the manufacture of gas, and for the

purposes of the waterworks; and showing thereon the proposed enlargement or extension of both gas and water works respectively, will be lodged at the Board of Trade, Whitehall-gardens, London, and that other copies will be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the county of Essex, at his office at Chelmsford, in the said county; in the office of the Clerk of the Parliaments, House of Lords, and in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons.

The Tramways Act, 1870.

The Blackburn and Over Darwen Tramways
Act, 1879.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the borough of Over Darwen, in the county of Lancaster, being the Local Authority of the district of Over Darwen, in which a tramway is laid, by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by the 46th section of the Tramways Act, 1870, have this day made certain Bye-laws or Regulations for regulating the rate of speed to be observed in travelling upon the tramways within the said district; the distances at which carriages using such tramways shall be allowed to follow one after the other; the stopping of carriages using the tramways; and the traffic on the road in which such tramway is laid (a copy of which Bye-laws and Regulations is set out in the schedule hereunder written).
