NOTICE is hereby given, that the Middlewich Gas-Light and Coke Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") intend to apply to the Board of Trade for a Provisional Order, under "The Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870," to be subsequently confirmed by Parliament, for the following purposes, or some of them, that is to say:—

To empower the Company to maintain and continue, and from time to time alter and enlarge, their existing gasworks and works connected therewith, and to continue to make gas, and supply and sell the same for all purposes within the townships of Middlewich, Kinderton-cum-Hulme, Sproston, Newton, Sutton, Croxton, and Ravenscroft, in the parish of Middlewich, and the township of Stanthorne, in the parish of Davenham, all in the county of Chester, and to manufacture coal-tar, coke, pitch, asphaltum, and ammoniacal liquor, oil, and all other residual products obtained in the manufacture of gas and matters producible therefrom, and to sell and dispose of the same at the works and elsewhere, and also to manufacture, purchase, or hire and sell, let, or deal in gas metres, fittings, gas stoves, gas engines and apparatus, and all other articles and things in any way connected with gasworks, or with the supply, use, or consumption of gas, and to take charges and remuneration in respect thereof; and also to authorise the Company to make such extensions of their mains, pipes, and works within the said townships of Middlewich, Kinderton-cum-Hulme, Sproston, Newton, Sutton, Croxton, Ravenscroft, and Stanthorne, as may in the opinion of the Company be necessary.

The land to be used for the manufacture of gas and residual products is the land hereinafter described, that is to say: All that piece of land containing 1,280 square yards, or thereabouts, belonging or reputed to belong to and in the occupation of the Company, and used by them as the site of their gasworks, situate, lying,
