THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 and 1884, and of every other power enabling them in

this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Orders of Council described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

2. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the said Orders, or any of them, before the commencement of this Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the said Orders, or any of them.

3. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the thirty-first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 and 1884, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Short Title.

1. This Order may be cited as THE FOREIGN ANIMALS ORDER OF 1885.

Extent.

2. This Order extends to England and Wales and Scotland only.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall commence and take effect from and immediately after the thirty-first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.
