WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent of the consolidated chapelry and benefice (hereinafter called the benefice) of Neasden - cum - Kingsbury, in the county of Middlesex, and in the diocese of London, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of two hundred pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twenty-first day of July, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and to be receivable in equal half-yearly portions, on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient, in our opinion, to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said benefice, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this fifth day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant and convey to the respective Incumbents for the time being of the several benefices within the diocese of Chichester, which are mentioned in the first column of the schedule hereunto annexed, the annual tenths or payments, the amount of which is in each case set opposite to the name of each benefice in the second column of the same schedule, which said annual tenths or payments were formerly payable to the Bishop of Chichester in respect of the said several benefices, and are now receivable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to have and hold the said several annual tenths or payments to the use of the respective Incumbents of the said several benefices and their successors for ever: Provided always, that the respective Incumbents for the time being of the said several benefices shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said annual tenths or payments for and in respect of the period intervening between the twenty-fifth day
