WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the consolidated chapelry and benefice of East Ville with Mid Ville, in the county of Lincoln, and in the diocese of Lincoln, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twenty-first day of August, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and to be receivable in four equal portions, on the first day of February, the first day of May,

the first day of August, and the first day of November in each, and every year: Provided always, that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said consolidated chapelry and benefice of East Ville with Mid Ville shall be paid only upon the production to us on or after each of the said lastly-mentioned days in each and every year of a certificate, under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of Lincoln, that an Assistant-Curate, duly licensed by such Bishop, has been employed within the consolidated chapelry aforesaid during the quarter of the year then ended, and is in receipt of a salary after a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty pounds per annum: Provided also, that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said consolidated chapelry and benefice of East Ville with Mid Ville.
