TREASURY WARRANT.

WHEREAS under a Convention lately entered into between the Postmaster-General of the United Kingdom and the Imperial German Postal Administration, each party guarantees the right of transit for Parcels over their territory, to or from any country with which they respectively have Parcel Post communication, subject to the stipulations in the said Convention contained.
