

for each offence, and not exceeding for any continuing offence, ten shillings for every day during which the offence continues. Provided nevertheless that the Justices or Court before whom any complaint may be made or any proceedings may be taken in respect of any such offence, may, if they think fit, adjudge the payment as a penalty of any sum less than the full amount of the penalty imposed by these Bye-laws and Regulations.

11. These Bye-laws and Regulations shall come into force on the 10th day of July, 1886.
