West Lulworth Water Works Undertaking.
Amended Notice of Intended Application for
Provisional Order.

NOTICE is hereby given, in pursuance of "The Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870" (33 and 34 Vict., c. 70), and "The Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870, Amendment Act, 1873" (36 and 37 Vict., c. 89), that Reginald Joseph Weld, of Lulworth Castle, in the county of Dorset, Esq., acting by Thomas Joseph Weld Blundell, of Lulworth Castle aforesaid, Esq., the Committee of his estate (he being a person of unsound mind, so found by inquisition), by and with the leave and sanction of the Master in Lunacy, intends to apply to the Board of Trade for a Provisional Order, pursuant to the said statutes and the rules and regulations made thereunder, for the following purposes, viz. :—

(a.) To empower the applicant or his successor

or successors in title, the owner or owners for the time being of the Lulworth Castle Estates, to maintain and continue the waterworks, and works connected therewith, recently erected and made, or now in the course of being erected and made in West Lulworth aforesaid :

(b.) To supply water to the village and the parish of West Lulworth aforesaid :

(c.) From time to time to alter and enlarge and renew the aforesaid waterworks and works connected therewith, and to erect and make, from time to time, such new and extended works as any increase in the demand for water or in the number of houses or buildings to be supplied may render necessary or expedient :

(d.) To enter upon any houses, buildings, lands, and premises supplied by him for any purpose relative to or connected with such supply :

(e.) To make, demand, levy, and take in respect of water supplied under the authority of such Provisional Order, rents or rates respectively, not exceeding the sums to be specified in such Provisional Order, subject and according to the regulations therein specified :

(f.) To incorporate in such Provisional Order the provisions of "The Waterworks Clauses Act, 1847," and of "The Waterworks Clauses Act, 1863."

The works consist of the reservoirs, water mains, valves, hydrants, cattle troughs, self-closing wall fountains, and the works in connection therewith, recently erected and in the course of erection by the aforesaid Reginald Joseph Weld, in the said parish of West Lulworth. The only new works proposed are such additions to or alterations in the above reservoirs, mains, and other works as may from time to time be or become necessary to meet any increase in the demand for water, or in the number of houses and buildings required to be supplied. Such new works (if any) will be made in the parish of and in the village of West Lulworth aforesaid.

The deposit under Part II of Schedule B to the said "Gas and Water Works Facilities Act, 1870," will be made on the 30th day of November, 1886, at the office of Thomas Ffooks, Esq., the Clerk of the Peace for the county of Dorset, at Sherborne, in the county of Dorset, and also at the office of the Board of Trade, situate at Whitehall, in the county of Middlesex.

Printed copies of the Draft Provisional Order when deposited, and of the Provisional Order when made, will be obtainable at the offices of Messrs. Palmer, Eland, and Nettleship, 4, Trafalgar-square, in the city of Westminster, or at the office of Mr. John Joseph Bates, at East Lulworth, in the county of Dorset.

All persons desirous of making any representation to the Board of Trade or of bringing before them any objection respecting the said application may do so by letter, addressed to the Assistant Secretary of the Railway Department of the Board of Trade, on or before the 15th day of January, 1887, and copies of their objections must be sent to the said applicant, and may be sent to the aforesaid office of the said Messrs. Palmer, Eland, and Nettleship.
