Liverpool Waterworks and Improvement.

(Agreements with Severn Commissioners and others as to Compensation Water; Sanctioning Deviations of authorized Works; Revision and Equalization of Water Charges and Water Supply within and without the City; Confirmation of Agreements as to Supply of Water, and further Powers to supply Water by agreement; Provisions as to raising money for Waterworks Extensions, and as to Sporting Rights on Reservoirs, and as to Pollution of Streams; Improvement of Chisenhale-street; Regulations as to Bands playing in Streets, Advertising Vehicles, Shooting Galleries, Whirl-go-rounds, &c., and as to Buildings, Courts, Back Streets, Furnaces, Ovens, Hoardings, Open Spaces about Buildings, and other matters; Amendment of section 26 of "Liverpool Sanitary Amendment Act, 1864," and of section 27 of "Liverpool Improvement Act, 1886;" Powers to borrow and apply Moneys, and to create Corporation Stock; Amendment of Acts.)

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that application will be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of Liverpool (hereinafter called "the Corporation") for an Act for all or some of the following objects or purposes, that is to say:—

To authorize agreements between the Corporation and the Severn Commissioners and all other persons and bodies corporate interested, for the alteration or modification of the provisions with respect to compensation water contained in the Liverpool Corporation Waterworks Act, 1880 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1880"), and to make further provisions with reference to such compensation water.

To define and enlarge the powers of the Corporation for the use of the works authorized by the Act of 1880, and the maintenance, cleansing,

repair, and inspection of their Vyrnwy Aqueduct, and works connected therewith, and to relieve the Corporation from liability to interference by injunction or otherwise in respect of the discharge of water from such aqueduct and works or any part thereof, and to make other provision with reference thereto.

To legalize and confirm and authorize the construction by the Corporation of the deviations hereinafter described of the Vyrnwy Aqueduct, authorized by the Act of 1880, beyond the limits of deviation shown on the plans and sections deposited for the purposes of that Act, and to empower the Corporation to maintain and use the works by that Act authorized as the same have been or may be constructed beyond such limits, and to make such provision as may be necessary with reference thereto and for vesting in and securing to the Corporation all such estate, rights, and interests in the lands in or through which such works are constructed as they have acquired or may require for the purposes aforesaid. The deviations above referred to are:—

1. A deviation to be situate partly in the township and parish of Whittington, and partly in the parish, town, and liberties of Oswestry, in the county of Salop, commencing in the field numbered on the deposited plans referred to in the Act of 1880, 1 in the said parish of Whittington, and terminating at the occupation road numbered on the said plans 10, in the said parish of Whittington, at a point about 3 chains from the south-west side of the Great Western Railway.

2. A deviation commencing in the township of Eaton, in the parish of Tarporley, in the county of Chester, in the field numbered on the said deposited plans 83 in that parish, and terminating in the township of Utkinton, in the parish of Tarporley aforesaid, in the road numbered on the said deposited plans 116 in that parish, near the junction therewith of the road numbered on the said plans 5 in the parish of Delamere.

3. A deviation to be wholly situate in the township of Oakmere, in the parish of Delamere, in the county of Chester, commencing in the public road numbered on the said deposited plans 15A in the said parish, at a point about 35 chains south of the point where the said road crosses the West Cheshire Railway, and terminating in the same road at a point about 25 chains north of the said crossing.

And to authorize the abandonment of those portions of the works authorized by the Act of 1880 which are rendered unnecessary by the said deviations.

To repeal, alter, vary, or amend all or some of the provisions now in force with respect to the levying and recovering by the Corporation of water-rates, and of rents or charges for the supply of water by them, whether within or without the city, and to make other and better provision in respect of the rates and rents and charges to be made for or in connection with the supply of water throughout the district of supply by the Corporation, and in respect of the incidence of such rates rents and charges as between owners and occupiers or otherwise, and as to the mode of estimating assessing and levying the same, and to make further provision for the supply of water for public purposes to the Corporations and other local authorities within the district of supply, and otherwise in reference thereto and the payment therefor.
