

along the centre of the said high road to a point opposite the hedge forming the northern boundary of a field called Little Knowle on the north side of a road leading out of the said Calne and Devizes-road to Broad's Green, then running east along the said hedge forming the northern boundary of the said field then turning northwards along the hedge forming a part of the western boundary of a field called Brown's Ground then turning and running eastward along the northern boundary of the said last-mentioned field then turning northward along the hedge forming a part of the western boundary of a field called Moon Croft then turning east along the hedge forming the northern boundary of the said last-mentioned field then turning north and running along a hedge forming part of the western boundary of a large field called Pool's Leaze then turning and running south-easterly along the hedges forming the north-eastern boundary of the said last-mentioned field and a field called Adjoining Pool's Leaze then turning north-east and then running along the

hedge forming the north-western boundary of the said last-mentioned field and continuing in an eastern direction along the hedge forming the northern boundary of a field called Paddock Field, then turning south along the hedge forming the eastern boundary of the said last-mentioned field then running in a north-easterly and easterly direction along the hedges forming the north-western and northern boundary of fields called Spick's Mead Field, Innick's Field and (also) Innick's Field then turning south-east and running along the hedge forming the north-eastern boundary of the said last-mentioned field then turning north-east and running along the hedge forming the south-eastern boundary of a field called the Acre Field to a point in the centre of a green track leading from Bowood to the Cherill Monument and then running in a south-easterly direction along the middle of the said track until it reaches the eastern boundary line of the said parish of Calne where it adjoins the parish of Blackland.
