

The unveiling was effected by R. Richardson-Gardner, Esq., Member of Parliament for the Borough of New Windsor, and by The Baron Schroeder, F. Barry, Esq., and E. Lawrence, Esq., The Vice-Chairmen of the Sub-Committees.

A. H. Thornton, Esq., Treasurer, and G. H. Long, Esq., Honorary Secretary of the Executive Committee, were presented to Her Majesty by General The Viscount Bridport, K.C.B., The Lord in Waiting.

The unveiling was announced by a flourish of trumpets sounded by the trumpeters of the Royal Horse Guards (Blue), stationed on either side of the pedestal, and by the drums of the 1st Battalion Coldstream Guards beating a ruffle, the troops presenting arms, and the bells of the parish church and of St. George's Chapel being rung.

Mrs. Simpson, the Mayoress of Windsor, Wife of the Chairman of the Jubilee Committee; Mrs. Richardson-Gardner, Miss Simpson, Miss Ricardo and Miss Barry presented Bouquets to The Queen and Royal Party.

The Naval and Military Knights of Windsor were stationed on the north side of the Quadrangle under their respective commanders.

Levée dress was worn by the Gentlemen of the Household in Waiting. Ladies in morning dress.

The streets and roads on the line of route, which were most tastefully decorated, were lined by the Royal Horse Guards, the 1st Battalion Coldstream Guards, the Berkshire and Buckinghamshire Volunteers, and by Police.
