In the High Court of Justice.—Chancery Division.

Mr Justice North.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts, 1862 and 1867, and in the Matter of the Champion Fire Lighter Syndicate Limited.

THE creditors of the abovenamed Company are required, on or before the 31st day of January, 1890, to send their names and addresses, and the particulars of their debts or claims, and the names and addresses of their Solicitors (if any), to William Roger Caldwell Moore, of 136 and 137, Palmerston-buildings, in the city of London, the Official Liquidator of the said Company; and, if so required, by notice in writing

from the said Official Liquidator, are, by their Solicitors, to come in and prove their said debts or claims at the chambers of Mr. Justice North, at the Royal Courts of Justice, Strand, in the county of Middlesex, at such time as shall be specified in such notice, or in default thereof they will be excluded from the benefit of any distribution made before such debts are proved. Thursday, the 13th day of February, 1890, at twelve o'clock at noon, at the said chambers, is appointed for hearing and adjudicating upon the debts and claims.—Dated this 17th day of December, 1889.
