

1886, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby revoke their Order bearing date the thirteenth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety, defining a part of the Port of London as a foreign animals quarantine station: Provided that nothing herein shall be deemed to invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the said Order before the date of this revocation, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the said Order.

THE Board of Agriculture, acting under The Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1886, hereby authorize the Local Authority for the county of Northampton to put in operation, within seven days after the date of this Authority, Article 6 of The Animals (Amendment) Order of 1887, dated the twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven providing for the slaughter by Local Authorities of cattle suspected of pleuro-pneumonia and the payment of compensation for the same, in respect of a cow suspected of being affected with pleuro-pneumonia the property of Mr. Birdseye, which cow is in a field in Cotten Road, in the parish of Hardingstone, near Northampton, in the occupation of Mr. Corbett.

This Authority is revocable by the Board of Agriculture.
