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| Manor Ward | Comprising all that part of the parish of Stoke Newington, bounded by a line running westwards along the centre of Church-street from High-street to Bouverie-road, along the centre of Bouverie-road to Grayling-road, along the centre of Grayling-road to Lordship-road, along the centre of Lordship-road to the southern boundary of the land occupied by the New River Water Company, along the southern and eastern boundary of the New River Water Company's land to Seven Sisters-road, then northwards along the centre of the Seven Sisters-road to the parish boundary, then eastwards and southwards along the north and east boundary of the parish to Church-street | 12 |
| Lordship Ward | Comprising all that part of the parish of Stoke Newington, bounded by a line running northwards along the centre of Bouverie-road, from Church-street to Grayling-road, along the centre of Grayling-road to Lordship-road, along the centre of Lordship-road to the southern boundary of the land occupied by the New River Water Company, along the southern and eastern boundary of the New River Water Company's land to the Seven Sisters-road, then northwards along the centre of the Seven Sisters-road to the parish boundary, then westwards along the north and western boundary of the parish to Church-street, then along the centre of Church-street to Bouverie-road | 15 |
| Church Ward | Comprising all that part of the parish of Stoke Newington bounded by a line running eastwards along the centre of Church-street from Church-path to the parish boundary in High-street, then south along the parish boundary to Broughton-road, then along the centre of Broughton-road to Albion-road, then southwards along the centre of Albion-road to Church-path, then along the centre of Church-path to Church-street | 15 |
| Clissold Ward | Comprising all that part of the parish of Stoke Newington bounded by a line running southwards along the centre of Church-path from Church-street to Parish Boundary, along the south-west portion of the boundary of the parish of Stoke Newington to Church-street, along the centre of Church-street to Church-path | 9 |
| Palatine Ward | Comprising all that south-eastern part of the parish of Stoke Newington bounded by a line running eastwards along the centre of Broughton-road, the Parish Boundary to Albion-road, along the centre of Albion-road to Church-path, then along the centre of Church-path to the Parish Boundary running along the extreme south-eastern portion of the Parish Boundary by way of the rear of the houses abutting on the north side of Allen-road, the rear of the premises abutting on the east side of Cowper-road, along the centre of St. Matthias-road, Boleyn-road, and Castle-street, thence along the centre of Stoke Newington-road, thence by the rear of the premises abutting on the south side of Brighton-road, by the east side of Nevill-road, to Broughton-road | 9 |

(PLEURO-PNEUMONIA.)

By the Board of Agriculture.
THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1890,

and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Place described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Place infected with pleuro-pneumonia.
