And whereas the said scheme or representation has been approved by Her Majesty in Council: now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said scheme or representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts; and Her Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the respective Registrars of the said diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, at Bristol, and at Gloucester.

#### PRESENT,

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

**W**HEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four and of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a Scheme or Representation bearing date the ninth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, in the words following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England acting under the provisions of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four, of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Your Majesty, chapter ninety-four; and of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme or representation for altering the boundaries of the new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) and of the new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors both in the county of Lancaster and in the diocese of Manchester.

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the eleventh day of August, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-one and published in the London Gazette upon the twelfth day of November following a part of the parish of Bolton-le-Moors in the said county of Lancaster and at that time in the diocese of Chester but now in the diocese of Manchester aforesaid was assigned as a district chapelry to the consecrated church called Saint George's Chapel situate within the limits of the said parish and the same district chapelry was called 'The Saint George's District.'

"And whereas by the authority of another Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the ninth day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six and published in the London Gazette on the thirteenth day of the same month certain contiguous portions of the new parish of Christ Church Bolton in the said county of Lancaster and in the diocese of Manchester aforesaid and of the said parish of Bolton-le-Moors were assigned as a consolidated chapelry to the consecrated church of Saint Paul situate within the limits of the said new parish of Christ Church Bolton aforesaid and the same consolidated chapelry was called 'The Consolidated Chapelry of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors.'

"And whereas both the said district chapelry of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) and the said consolidated chapelry of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors have under the provisions of the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Your Majesty chapter one hundred and four, become new parishes of the character contemplated by that Act and by the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Your Majesty, chapter thirty-seven, and by the above-mentioned Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four.

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) and of the said new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors should be altered in the manner hereinafter mentioned.

"Now therefore with the consent of the Right Reverend James, Bishop of the said diocese of Manchester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme or representation) we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries both of the said new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) and of the said new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors shall be altered so that all that portion of the said new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) which is described in the Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto appended and is thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such new parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors.

"And we further represent recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing recommending or proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"The SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be dissevered from the new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) in the county of Lancaster and in the diocese of Manchester and to be annexed to the new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors in the same county and diocese being:—

"All that part of the said new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) which is bounded upon part of the north by the new parish of Saint Luke Halliwell in the said county and diocese upon the west and upon the south-west by the parish of Dean in the same county and diocese upon the south-east partly by the new parish of The Saviour Bolton-le-Moors in the county and diocese aforesaid and partly by the new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors aforesaid and upon the remaining sides that is to say upon the north-west and upon the remaining part of the north by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Paul Bolton-le-Moors from the new parish of Saint George (Bolton-le-Moors) aforesaid at the bridge which carries over the River Croal the roadway connecting Grime-street with Pool-street and extending thence northward for a distance of two chains or thereabouts along the middle of the said roadway and along the middle of Pool-street
