If he find the stock to be in any respect incorrect, he shall make such addition to the said certificate as he may deem necessary, specifying the particulars in which he finds the quantities of stock to be incorrectly stated.

ARTICLE VII.—The Master of the Workhouse shall, when required by the Stocktaker to do so, on the days and at the times referred to in Article V, submit to him the stores and Accounts therein mentioned, and render to him such assistance as may be necessary for the purpose of such examination and comparison as aforesaid.

ARTICLE VIII.—The Master of the Workhouse shall lay each of the said Accounts before the Guardians at their next meeting after the date of the entry therein of any such certificate as aforesaid.

ARTICLE IX.—So long as a Stocktaker is appointed it shall not be necessary for the Visiting Committee to examine the stores of to enter in any Account the memorandum required by the above-cited Order dated the fourteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

ORDER of the Local Government Board: Altering General Consolidated Order: Allowance of Tobacco and Snuff to certain Paupers in the Workhouse:—

Richmond Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Richmond Union, in the County of Surrey;—

And to all others when it may concern

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by a General Order dated the 24th day of July, 1847, addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the said Richmond Union (amongst others), the Poor Law Commissioners made certain Rules and Regulations with regard to the government of the Workhouse of the said Union;

And whereas it is expedient that further provision should be made as hereinafter mentioned:

Now therefore, We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby Order that, from and after the date hereof, the following regulations shall be in force in the said Richmond Union, namely,—

ARTICLE I.—Tobacco or snuff may be allowed to such of the inmates of the Workhouse of the Union who are not able-bodied, or are employed upon work of a specially disagreeable character, as the Guardians may consider should be supplied with the same, the quantity to be allowed in each case, or in any class of cases, to be such as the Guardians may by resolution prescribe.

ARTICLE II.—So much of Article 121 of the

said General Order as provides that no pauper shall smoke in any room in the Workhouse without the special direction of the Medical Officer shall be rescinded, so far asyregards the said Union; but the Guardians may from time to time, by resolution, determine in what rooms and at what times smoking shall be allowed, and no pauper shall smoke in the Workhouse in any other room or at any other time than is so allowed.
