CEREMONIAL observed at the Marriage of Her, Highness The Princess Franzisca Josepha Louise Augusta Marie Christiana Helena, Grand Daughter of Her Majesty The Queen, and Youngest Daughter of Their Royal Highnesses The Prince and Princess Christian of Schleswig-Holstein (Princess Helena of Great Britain and Ireland), with His Highness The Prince Aribert Joseph Alexander of Anhalt, G.C.B., in St. George's Chapel, Windsor Castle, on Monday, the 6th July, 1891, at 4 o'clock.

Her Majesty's Guests invited to be present at the Ceremony who came from London by Special Train leaving Paddington at 2.45 o'clock, arrived at Windsor at 3.20 o'clock, and proceeded at once to the South Entrance to St. George's Chapel, and were shown to seats provided for them in the Choir, to which the Guests at the Castle and resident in the neighbourhood were also shown.

The Archbishop of Canterbury and The Dean and Canons and Minor Canons of Windsor assembled at the Deanery, and took their places within the Rails of the Altar at 3.40 o'clock. A March by Lemmens being played on the Organ as they proceeded up the Choir.
