GENERAL ORDER of the Local Government Board: Altering General Consolidated Order: Apprenticeship of Pauper Children:—

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Holborn Union, in the county of London;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by a General Order dated the 24th day of July, 1847, addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the said Holborn Union, among others, the Poor Law Commissioners prescribed certain Regulations to be observed by the said Guardians, including provisions with regard to the apprenticeship of pauper children chargeable to the said Union:

Now We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the

Statutes in that behalf, hereby alter the said Order so as to provide that We may assent, in any case where it may seem to be necessary or expedient, to a departure from any of the Regulations contained in the said Order with regard to the apprenticeship of pauper children chargeable to the said Union.

ORDER of the Local Government Board: Suspension in part of General Order: Medical Officer's Fees.

Sheffield Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Sheffield Union, in the County Borough of Sheffield and the County of the West Riding of Yorkshire;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

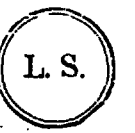
WHEREAS the Poor Law Commissioners, by a General Order bearing date the twenty-fourth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, made certain rules and regulations relating to the administration of relief to the Poor within certain Unions, including the said Sheffield Union; and by Articles 177, 182, and 183 of the said Order provision was made for the payment of special fees to Medical Officers in certain cases;

And whereas the Guardians of the Poor of the said Union, in pursuance of the provisions of Article 158 of the said General Order, have divided the Union into Districts for Medical Relief, and one of such Districts is termed the "Central District";

And whereas it is expedient to suspend, as hereinafter mentioned, the operation of the said Articles 177, 182, and 183 as regards the Medical Officer for the said "Central District":

Now therefore, We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby suspend the operation, until We by Order shall otherwise direct, of Articles 177, 182, and 183 of the above-cited Order with respect to the Medical Officer for the time being for the said "Central District," in the said Sheffield Union.
