(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.)

By the Board of Agriculture.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1890, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The following Place (namely),—all that sale-yard, commonly used for the sale of cattle, sheep,

the Eastern Division of the county of Sussex, in the occupation of Mr. Thomas Bannister, -which was declared by Order of the Board dated the nineteenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, to be a Place infected with foot-and-mouth disease, is hereby declared to be free from foot-and-mouth disease, and that Place shall, as from the commencement of this Order, cease to be a Place infected with foot-andmouth disease.

2. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after this twenty-sixth day of February, . one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two.
