WHEREAS by the first section of "The Colonial Probates Act, 1892," it is enacted as follows:—

"Her Majesty the Queen may, on being satisfied that the legislature of any British possession has made adequate provision for the recognition in that possession of probates and letters of administration granted by the Courts of the United Kingdom, direct by Order in Council that this Act shall, subject to any exceptions and modifications specified in the Order, apply to that possession, and thereupon, while the Order is in force, this Act shall apply accordingly."

And whereas Her Majesty is satisfied that the Legislatures of the British Possessions herein-after mentioned have made adequate provision for the recognition in those Possessions of probates and letters of administration granted by the Courts of the United Kingdom.

Now therefore Her Majesty by virtue and in exercise of the powers by the above recited Act in Her Majesty vested is pleased by and with the

advice of Her Most Honourable Privy Council to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:

"The Colonial Probates Act, 1892," shall apply to the British Possessions hereunder mentioned:—

- Hong Kong.
- Western Australia, and
- The Province of Ontario in the Dominion of Canada.

And the Most Honourable the Marquess of Ripon Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the Colonies is to give the necessary directions herein accordingly. C. L. Peel.

WHEREAS by "The Weights and Measures Act, 1878," it is (among other things) provided that it shall be lawful for Her Majesty from time to time, by Order in Council, to define the amount of error to be tolerated in local standards when verified or re-verified by the Board of Trade, or when re-verified by such a local comparison as is authorized by section forty-one of the said Act; and to revoke and vary any Order made for the purposes of the Act:

And whereas by an Order in Council dated the twenty-ninth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, Her Majesty was pleased to define the amounts of errors to be then tolerated in local Standards when verified or re-verified by the Board of Trade, as referred to in the Schedule annexed to the said Order:

And whereas it has been now made to appear that the amounts of errors referred to in the Schedule hereto should also be tolerated on such Standards when locally re-verified by a comparison in the presence of a Justice of the Peace:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by virtue of the power vested in Her by the said Act, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, is pleased to define that the amounts of errors set forth in the Schedule hereto may from and after the date of this Order be tolerated in local Standards when so locally re-verified.
