the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of the following Telegram, dated 17th April, 1893, from Her Majesty's Representative at Madrid:—“My Telegram, No. 20 Commercial—Cases of yellow fever having occurred in outer roads at a distance of fifteen miles from Buenos Ayres, free pratique will only be granted to arrivals from that port which have not been in outer roads.”
