

road for a distance of twenty-three and a half chains or thereabouts to its junction with Lancaster-road and extending thence eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of fifteen and a quarter chains or thereabouts to its junction with Montague-road, and extending thence northward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of six and three quarter chains or thereabouts to its junction with Fernald-road, and extending thence eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of one and three quarter chains or thereabouts to a point at its eastern end upon the western boundary of Wanstead Flats, and extending thence due east and in a straight line for a distance of eleven chains to the boundary on the said Wanstead Flats which boundary divides the said district parish of Leytonstone from the parish of Wanstead aforesaid."

And whereas the said representation has been approved by Her Majesty in Council: now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts; and Her Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said diocese of Saint Albans.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four and of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a scheme or representation bearing date the first day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, in the words following, that is to say;

"We the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England acting under the provisions of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four and of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme or representation for altering the boundaries of the new parish of New Milverton in the county of Warwick and in the diocese of Worcester.

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the twenty-sixth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five and published in the London Gazette on the twenty-ninth day of the same month a certain part of the parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton in the said county and diocese was constituted a separate district for spiritual purposes, and the same was named 'The District of New Milverton.'

"And whereas the said district of New Milverton has under the provisions of the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Your Majesty

chapter one hundred and four become a new parish of the character contemplated by that Act and by the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Your Majesty chapter thirty-seven and by the above-mentioned Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four.

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said new parish of New Milverton should be altered so as to include within its limits a certain additional part of the said parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton.

"Now therefore with the consent of the Right Reverend John James Stewart Bishop of the said diocese of Worcester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme or representation) we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation the boundaries of the said new parish of New Milverton shall be altered so as to include within its limits all that additional part of the said parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton which is described in the Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto appended and is thereon coloured pink and that from and after the same date and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the said part of the said parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton so to be included as aforesaid shall become annexed to and become and be and shall form part of the said new parish of New Milverton.

"And we further represent recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing recommending or proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore-mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"The SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be annexed to the new parish of New Milverton, in the county of Warwick and in the diocese of Worcester being:—

"All that part of the parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton in the said county and diocese which is bounded upon the east and upon the south-east by the said new parish of New Milverton upon the west by the new parish of All Saints Emscote in the county and diocese aforesaid or in other words by the municipal boundary in the middle of the River Avon which divides the borough of Royal Leamington Spa from the borough of Warwick and upon the remaining sides that is to say upon the north-west and upon the north by an imaginary line commencing at the point in the middle of the said river upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of All Saints Emscote from the parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton aforesaid where the municipal boundary of the borough of Royal Leamington Spa leaving the middle of the said river bends towards the north-east and extending thence first north-eastward and then eastward along the last-mentioned municipal boundary for a distance of seventeen and a half chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of the line of the Coventry and Leamington Branch of the London and North-Western Railway upon the boundary which divides the said parish or parochial chapelry of Milverton from the new parish of New Milverton aforesaid."
