WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction consisting of a piece or parcel of land, comprising one thousand four hundred and fifty-eight square yards, or thereabouts, which has been permanently secured as a site for a parsonage or house of residence for the vicarage of Saint Barnabas, Bexhill, in the county of Sussex, and in the diocese of Chichester, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said vicarage of Saint Barnabas, Bexhill, to meet such benefaction, one capital sum of seven hundred pounds sterling, to be applicable towards defraying the cost of providing a parsonage or house of residence for the said vicarage, according to plans and a specification approved or to be approved by us, such capital sum, or the balance
