No. 5 Ward.	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west from the parish boundary where it is cut by Cooper's-road by a line drawn across the railway to Reverdy-road, along the centre of Reverdy-road and Southwark Park-road, from Reverdy-road to Rouel-road, along the centre of Rouel-road to Spa-road; on the north by a line drawn along the centre of Spa-road from the point where it is cut by Rouel-road to St. James' Church, along the wall of the Church grounds to St. James'-road; on the east by a line commencing at the Mission Room of St. James' Church and drawn along the centre of St. James'-road, Anchor-lane, Southwark Park-road, from the point where it is cut by Anchor-lane to the point where it is cut by Galley Wall-road, along the centre of Galley Wall-road; on the south by the parish boundary from the point where it is cut by Galley Wall-road to the point where it is cut by Cooper's-road	21
No. 6 Ward.	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west by a line drawn along the centre of Anchor-lane and St. James'-road, along the boundary wall of St. James' Church ground to Spa-road, along the centre of Spa-road, across Jamaica-road, along the centre of Princes'-road, across Bermondsey-wall to the parish boundary at Fountain Dock; on the north by the parish boundary from Fountain Dock to West-lane; on the east by the parish boundary from the river to the point where it is cut by the South Eastern Railway; on the south from the South Eastern Railway at the parish boundary by a line drawn along the centre of Southwark Park-road to Anchor-lane	18
	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west by a line drawn along the centre of the road opposite Rouel-road to Jamaica-road at a point opposite Marine-street, along Jamaica-road and Dock-head to St. Saviour's Dock, along the parish boundary to the river; on the north by the parish boundary from St. Saviour's Dock to Fountain Dock; on the east by a line drawn from the parish boundary at Fountain Dock, across Bermondsey-wall, along the centre of Princes'-road, across Jamaica-road, along Spa-road to the boundary wall of St. James' Church grounds; on the south by a line drawn along the centre of Spa-road from the boundary wall of St. James' Church grounds to Neckinger-road	15

The Vestry of the Parish of St. Mary, Stratford-le-Bow, and all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by the Metropolis Management Amendment Act, 1862, Section 41, it is enacted that, when at any time, upon any account taken of the population by the Authority of Parliament any of the parishes within the Metropolis not now divided into wards for the purpose of electing vestrymen shall be found to contain more than two thousand rated householders, it shall be lawful for the Metropolitan Board of Works, upon the application in writing of the vestry, or of not less than five hundred

rated householders of the parish, to divide such parish into wards, and to determine and set out the number, extent, limit and boundary lines of such wards, but so nevertheless that no ward shall contain less than five hundred rated householders, and that the whole number of wards shall not exceed eight, and the Metropolitan Board shall apportion among the several wards the number of vestrymen to be elected for such parish, and shall in assigning the number of vestrymen to each ward have regard, as far as in their judgment is practicable, as well to the number of persons rated to the relief of the poor in each
