In the High Court of Justice.—Chancery Division. In the Matter of the Alliance Land and Dwellings Company Limited and Reduced; and in the Matter of the Companies Act, 1867; and in the Matter of the Companies Act, 1877.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Order of the Chancery Division of the High Court of Justice, made by Mr. Justice Wright, on the 13th July, 1894, that the cancellation and reduction of the capital of the abovenamed Company resolved on and effected by the Special Resolution passed and confirmed at two Extraordinary Meetings of the Company held on the 6th April, and the 25th April, 1894, be confirmed, together with the following Minute, approved by the Court, namely:—“The capital of the Alliance Land and Dwellings Company Limited is henceforth £350,000, divided into

100,000 shares of £3 10s. each, instead of the original capital of £1,000,000, divided into 100,000 shares of £10 each. At the time of the registration of this Minute 1,257 of such shares of £3 10s. each are held by Shareholders, upon each of which the sum of £3 10s. has been and is to be deemed fully paid up, except that calls to the amount of £108 are in arrear on 53 of such shares; of the remaining shares 98,729 have not been issued, and nothing is to be deemed paid upon them; and 14 shares, the residue of the said 100,000 shares, have been forfeited to the Company, and have not been re-issued.” was duly registered on the 27th July, 1894.—Dated the 28th July, 1894.
