

AT the Court at *Osborne House, Isle of Wight*,
the 7th day of *August*, 1894.

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS the Honourable Evan Charteris, Barrister-at-Law, duly appointed in pursuance of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1882," as Commissioner for determining the boundaries of the Wards of the borough of Lewes, and for apportioning the Councillors thereto, has transmitted to one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State his scheme in the following terms:—

"WHEREAS Her Majesty has been pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council and in pursuance and exercise of the power vested in Her Majesty by the Municipal Corporations Act 1882, to fix the number of Wards into which the borough of Lewes in the county of Sussex shall be divided and to order and direct that the said borough shall be divided into three Wards which Order was made on the thirtieth day of April one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.

"And whereas on the tenth day of May in the year last aforesaid the Right Honourable Herbert Henry Asquith Her Majesty's Secretary of State for the Home Department did duly appoint me the Honourable Evan Edward Charteris Barrister-at-Law for the purpose of determining the boundaries of such Wards and apportioning the number of the Councillors of the said borough among such Wards as in the said Municipal Corporations Act, 1882 mentioned.

"Now I the said Evan Edward Charteris do hereby, in pursuance of the powers given me by virtue of the said appointment under the said Act determine as hereinafter mentioned the boundaries of the three wards into which the said borough is to be divided which Wards are hereinafter numbered and named as follows that is to say, Ward No. 1 otherwise the Bridge Ward, Ward No. 2 otherwise the Castle Ward, Ward No. 3 otherwise the Priory Ward.

"And I do hereby determine that the said Ward No. 1 otherwise the Bridge Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Lewes as is contained within a line which commences where the boundary of that part of the parish of South Malling which is within the borough intersects the northern boundary of the borough and then passes in an easterly direction along the north boundary of the borough then turning southwards along the eastern boundary of the borough follows the said boundary to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of South Malling then turning north along the boundary of the parish of South Malling to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of Saint Thomas à Becket Cliffe then, passes along the south-west boundary of the parish of Saint Thomas à Becket Cliffe to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of All Saints then turning in a westerly direction along the south boundary of the parish of All Saints to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of Saint Michael then turning north along the west and north boundaries of the parish of All Saints to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of South Malling and then turning north-west along the south-west boundary of the parish of South Malling to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"Such ward including the whole of the parishes of All Saints and Saint Thomas à Becket Cliffe and that part of the parish of South Malling which is within the borough:

"And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 2 otherwise the Castle Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Lewes as is contained within a line which commences at a point where the boundary of that part of the parish of South Malling which is within the borough intersects the northern boundary of the borough and then passes in a westerly direction along the north and north-west boundaries of the borough to a point where the boundary of the borough intersects the boundary of the parish of Saint John under the Castle then turning south along the western and south-western boundaries of the parish of Saint John under the Castle to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of Saint Michael and then turning south along the western boundary of the parish of Saint Michael to a point where the boundary of the parish of Saint Michael meets the boundary of the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover then turning east along the southern boundary of the parish of Saint Michael to a point where the boundary of the parish of Saint Michael meets the boundary of the parish of All Saints then turning north along the boundary of the parish of Saint Michael to a point where the said boundary meets the boundary of the parish of Saint John under the Castle and turning east and north along the boundary of the parish of Saint John under the Castle to a point where such boundary meets the boundary of the parish of South Malling and thence along the north-eastern boundary of that part of the parish of Saint John under the Castle which is within the borough to the point of commencement aforesaid.

"Such ward including the whole of the parishes of Saint Michael and Castle Precincts and that part of the parish of Saint John under the Castle which is within the borough.

"And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 3 otherwise the Priory Ward shall comprise so much of the borough of Lewes as is contained within a line which commences at a point where the boundary of that part of the parish of Saint Peter and Saint Mary Westout otherwise Saint Anne which is within the borough intersects the north-western boundary of the borough and then passes in a southerly direction along the north-western and western boundaries of the borough and follows the said borough boundary to the point on the extreme south-west of the borough, where the said boundary turns to the east and following the said boundary passes in an easterly direction along the southern boundary of the borough to a point where the said boundary is intersected by the boundary which separates the parish of Kingston from the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover thence continuing along the southern boundary of the borough to the point where the said boundary meets the eastern boundary of the borough thence turning north along the said eastern boundary of the borough to a point where the boundary of the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover meets the boundary of that part of the parish of South Malling which is within the borough thence continuing in a northerly direction along the boundary of the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover to a point where the boundary of the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover meets the boundary of the parish of Saint Thomas à Becket Cliffe then turning west along the north boundary of the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover to a point where the boundary of the parish of Saint John the Baptist Southover meets the boundary of the parish of Saint Peter and Saint Mary Westout otherwise Saint Anne then turning
