Stanley.	Comprising all that part of the parish of St. Luke, Chelsea, bounded on the west by the parish boundary from the south-western corner of the parish to Stamford-bridge; on the north by the parish boundary from Stamford-bridge to Church-street; on the east by a line drawn along the centre of Church-street from the parish boundary on the north to the parish boundary on the south; on the south by the parish boundary from Church-street to the south-western corner of the parish .. .. .	12
Church and Cheyne.	Comprising all that part of the parish of Chelsea bounded on the west by a line drawn along the centre of Church-street from the parish boundary on the south to the parish boundary on the north; on the north by the parish boundary from Church-street to Marlborough-road; on the east by a line drawn along the centre of Marlborough-road from the parish boundary on the north to Whitehead's-grove, along the centre of Whitehead's-grove to College-street, along the centre of Markham-street from College-street to King's-road, along the centre of King's road from Markham-street to Smith-street, along the centre of Smith-street to the western gate of Chelsea Hospital, thence along the private road by the western boundary of Chelsea Hospital grounds to the parish boundary on the south; on the south by the parish boundary from opposite the western end of Chelsea Hospital grounds to opposite Church-street .. .. .	15
Hans Town.	Comprising all that part of the parish of Chelsea bounded on the west, north, and east by the parish boundary from Marlborough-road to a point opposite Ellis-street; on the south by a line drawn from a point opposite Ellis-street across D'Oyley-street, and along the centre of Ellis-street, Cadogan-terrace, and Cadogan-street from the parish boundary on the east to Marlborough-road .. .. .	12
Royal Hospital.	Comprising all that part of the parish of Chelsea bounded on the west by the private road at the western boundary of the Chelsea Hospital grounds, across the western gate of the Chelsea Hospital, and thence by a line drawn along the centre of Smith-street, along the centre of King's road from Smith-street to Markham-street, and along the centre of Markham-street from King's-road to Whitehead's-grove; on the north by a line drawn along the centre of Whitehead's-grove, Cadogan-street, Cadogan-terrace and Ellis-street, and thence by a straight line across D'Oyley-street to the parish boundary on the east; on the east and south by the parish boundary from a point opposite Ellis-street to a point opposite the western boundary of Chelsea Hospital grounds .. .. .	9
Kensal Town.	Comprising all that part of the parish of Chelsea known as "Chelsea detached" and situate to the north of Kensington and the north-west of Paddington, and bounded on all sides by the parish boundary.. .. .	12
