

**ORDER REARRANGING WARDS OF THE PARISH OF BERMONDSEY.**

WHEREAS the London County Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by Section 15 of the London County Council (General Powers) Act, 1893, have prepared an Order, dated the 19th day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, rearranging the wards of the parish of Bermondsey, being a parish mentioned in Schedule A to the Metropolitan Management Act, 1855, and determining the number, limits, and boundary lines of the new wards, and apportioning among the several wards the number of vestrymen to be elected for such parish in accordance with the limitations prescribed by the said Section.

And whereas such Order was transmitted to me for approval on the twenty-fifth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, and was published in the London Gazette on the twenty-sixth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.

And whereas power is given to me by the said section, if I disapprove of the proposed rearrangement of wards or apportionment of vestrymen, to make, subject to the limitations prescribed in

the said section, such other Order as to the rearrangement or apportionment as in my judgment shall be more conducive to a fair representation in the vestry of the interests of the ratepayers of the parish.

And whereas I disapprove of the rearrangement into wards of the parish of Bermondsey proposed in the said Order of the London County Council.

I hereby, in pursuance of the said power, order that the wards of the said parish of Bermondsey be rearranged in manner following, namely, that the said parish be divided into six wards, that the six wards be distinguished by the numbers and names mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, that the extent, limits, and boundary lines of such wards shall be those described in the second column of the said Schedule, and that the number of vestrymen to be elected for each of the said wards shall be the number mentioned in the third column of the said Schedule.

No. 1 Ward.	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west by the parish boundary commencing at the point where it is cut by John-street and finishing at the point where it is cut by Long-lane; on the north by the parish boundary from the point where it is cut by Long-lane to the point where it is cut by Bermondsey-street; on the east by a line drawn through the centre of Bermondsey-street, Star-corner, and Grange-road as far as John's-place; on the south by a line through the centre of John's-place, Paragon-alley, Cross-street, Brandon-street, John-street, to the point where it is cut by the parish boundary .. .. .	21
No. 2 Ward.	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west by a line drawn through the centre of Grange-road commencing at the point where it is cut by John's-place, through Star-corner and Bermondsey-street to the parish boundary; on the north by the parish boundary from the point where it is cut by Bermondsey-street to St. Saviour's Dock, and thence by a line along the centre of Dockhead; on the east by a line drawn along the centre of Dockhead and Jamaica-road as far as the road opposite Marine-street, along the centre of that road to Spa-road; on the south by a line drawn along the centre of Spa-road commencing at Rouel-road to the point where it is cut by Grange-road, along Grange-road to Star-corner .. .. .	24
No. 3 Ward.	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west by a line commencing at the parish boundary and drawn along the centre of John-street, Brandon-street, Cross-street, Paragon-alley, and John's-place; on the north by a line drawn along the centre of Grange-road to Spa-road, along the centre of Spa-road to Rouel-road; on the east by a line drawn along the centre of Rouel-road, Southwark Park-road, from Rouel-road to Reverdy-road, along Reverdy-road to Alderminster-road, across the railway to the parish boundary at Cooper's-road; on the south by the parish boundary, commencing at the point where it is cut by Cooper's-road to the point where it is cut by John-street .. .. .	21
No. 4 Ward.	That portion of the parish of Bermondsey which is bounded on the west from the parish boundary where it is cut by Cooper's-road by a line drawn across the railway to Reverdy-road, along the centre of Reverdy-road and Southwark Park-road, from Reverdy-road to Rouel-road, along the centre of Rouel-road to Spa-road; on the north by a line drawn along the centre of Spa-road from the point where it is
