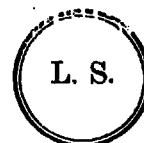

| Brompton Ward. | Comprising all that part of the parish of Kensington bounded on the west by the parish boundary from the south-western corner of the parish to Richmond-road, and thence by a line drawn along the centre of Richmond-road, from the parish boundary on the west to Earl's-court-road, and along the centre of Earl's-court-road from Richmond-road to Cromwell-road; on the north by a line drawn along the centre of Cromwell-road from Earl's-court-road to Gloucester-road; on the east by a line drawn along the centre of Gloucester-road and Cranley-gardens from Cromwell-road to the parish boundary; on the south by the parish boundary from Cranley-gardens to the south-western corner of the parish | 15 |

ORDER OF LONDON COUNTY COUNCIL
RE-ARRANGING THE WARDS OF THE
PARISH OF SAINT MARY, NEWINGTON,
APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF
STATE.

To the Vestry of the Parish of Saint Mary,
Newington;
And all whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 15 of the London
County Council (General Powers) Act, 1893,
it is enacted that the London County Council
may from time to time for the purpose of
elections of vestrymen, upon the application in

writing of the vestry, or of not less than five
hundred rated householders of a parish mentioned
in Schedules A and B to the Metropolis Manage-
ment Act, 1855, by order under their seal, re-
arrange the wards in such parish, and determine
the number, extent, limits, and boundary lines of
the new wards, but so nevertheless that no ward
shall contain less than five hundred rated house-
holders, and that the whole number of wards
shall not exceed eight, and the Council shall, in
making any such re-arrangement apportion
among the several wards the number of vestry-
men to be elected for such parish, and shall in
assigning the number of vestrymen to each ward
