And whereas it is expedient that the provisions of the General Orders addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the several Unions in England and Wales, and in force in such Unions, and of certain General Orders which are specified in the Schedule to this Order, issued from time to time by the Poor Law Commissioners, the Poor Law Board, and by Us, should be made applicable to and be in force in the said Stoke-upon-Trent Union :

Now we, the Local Government Board, hereby Order as follows :—

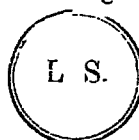

ORDER of the Local Government Board making certain Orders applicable to new Union :—
Saddleworth Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Saddleworth Union ;—

To the Overseers of the Poor of the several Parishes comprised in the said Union ;—
And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by an Order dated the 19th day of November, 1894, We, the Local Government Board, ordered that, from and after the appointed day as defined by Section 84 of the Local Government Act, 1894, the Parishes of Saddleworth, Uppermill, and Quickmere (Middle Division) formed by the operation of the said Act, and named by an Order of the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire, acting by the West Riding Boundaries Committee, should from and after the said appointed day, be united for the administration of the laws for the relief of the Poor, and form a Union, to be termed the Saddleworth Union ;

And whereas it is expedient that the provisions of the General Orders addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the several Unions in England and Wales, and in force in such Unions, and of certain General Orders which are specified in the Schedule to this Order, issued from time to time by the Poor Law Commissioners, the Poor Law Board, and by Us, should be made applicable to and be in force in the said Saddleworth Union :

Now We, the Local Government Board, hereby order as follows :—

From and after the twenty-eighth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, the provisions of the above-mentioned General Orders shall, subject to the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1894, apply to and be in force in the said Union.
