WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four and of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a scheme or representation bearing date the sixth day of December, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England acting under the provisions of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four and of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme or representation for altering the boundaries of the new parishes of Saint Mary Streatham, of Upper Tooting, and of the Ascension Balham Hill all in the county of Surrey and in the diocese of Rochester.

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the thirteenth day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five and published in the London Gazette on the thirty-first day of the same month certain parts of the parish of Streatham in the said county and at that time in the diocese of Winchester, but now in the said diocese of Rochester were assigned as district chapelries to the consecrated churches of Saint Mary situate at Balham and of the Holy Trinity situate at Upper Tooting both in the said parish of Streatham and the same districts were named respectively 'The District Chapelry of Saint Mary Streatham' and 'The District Chapelry of Upper Tooting.'

"And whereas the said district chapelries of Saint Mary Streatham and of Upper Tooting have each of them under the provisions of the Act of the nineteenth and twentieth years of Your Majesty chapter one hundred and four become a new parish of the character contemplated by that Act and by the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Your Majesty chapter thirty-seven and by the above-mentioned Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four.

"And whereas by the authority of another Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the thirtieth day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four and published in a Supplement to the London Gazette on the thirty-first day of the same month and also in the London Gazette on the second day of January following certain portions of the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham and of the parish of Clapham in the said county of Surrey and in the diocese of Rochester aforesaid were assigned as a consolidated chapelry to the consecrated church of the Ascension situate in Malwood-road Balham Hill and the same district was named 'The Consolidated Chapelry of the Ascension Balham Hill.'

"And whereas the said consolidated chapelry of the Ascension Balham Hill has also under the provisions of the lastly-mentioned Acts become a new parish of the character contemplated by those Acts.

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said new parishes of Saint Mary Streatham, of Upper Tooting, and of the Ascension Balham Hill should be altered in the manner hereinafter mentioned.

"Now therefore with the consent of the Right Reverend Randall Thomas Bishop of the said diocese of Rochester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme or representation) we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order (Firstly) the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham and of the said new parish of Upper Tooting shall be altered so that all those portions of the said new parish of Upper Tooting which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto appended and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such new parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham (Secondly) that in like manner the boundaries of the said new parish of Upper Tooting and of the said new parish of the Ascension Balham Hill shall be altered so that all that portion of the said new parish of Upper Tooting which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured yellow shall be dissevered from the last-named new parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said new parish of the Ascension Balham Hill (Thirdly) that the boundaries of the said new parish of Upper Tooting shall be further altered so as to comprise (firstly) all that portion of the parish of Battersea in the said county of Surrey and in the diocese of Rochester aforesaid which is described in the first part of the Third Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured green and (secondly) all that portion of the parish of Saint Anne Wandsworth in the last-named county and diocese which is described in the second part of the said Third Schedule and is delineated on the said map or plan and is thereon coloured brown and (thirdly and fourthly) all those portions of the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham which are described in the third and fourth parts
