

of the said Third Schedule and are delineated on the said map or plan and are thereon coloured blue.

"And we further represent recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing recommending or proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or to any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"The SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The FIRST SCHEDULE."

"The territory to be dissevered from the new parish (sometime district chapelry) of Upper Tooting, in the county of Surrey and in the diocese of Rochester and to be annexed to the new parish (sometime district chapelry) of Saint Mary Streatham in the same county and diocese being:—

"I. All that portion of the said new parish of Upper Tooting which is bounded upon the east by the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham and upon all other sides that is to say upon the north upon the west and upon the south by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham from the new parish of Upper Tooting aforesaid crosses the middle of the line of the London Brighton and South Coast Railway and extending thence north-westward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of ten chains or thereabouts to a point at or near to the south-east corner of Wandsworth Common where the boundary which divides the said new parish of Upper Tooting from the parish of Battersea in the county and diocese aforesaid joins the boundary dividing the same new parish of Upper Tooting from the consolidated chapelry of Saint Mary Magdalene Wandsworth Common in the said county and diocese and extending thence southward along the last-mentioned boundary for a distance of sixteen chains or thereabouts (thereby crossing Balham Park-road passing at the backs of the houses situate on the western side of Heslop-road, and crossing Sarsfield-road) to a point in the middle of Boundaries-road opposite to Boundaries House, and extending thence eastward along the middle of the said road for a distance of three chains or thereabouts to its junction with Tunley-road; and extending thence southward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of thirteen chains or thereabouts to its junction with Marius-road and extending thence eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of five chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said new parish of Upper Tooting from the new parish of Saint Mary Streatham aforesaid.

"II. And also all that other portion of the said new parish of Upper Tooting which is bounded upon the east and upon the north by the new parish of Saint Mary Streatham aforesaid and upon the remaining sides that is to say upon the west and upon the south by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham from the new parish of Upper Tooting aforesaid at a point in Balham High-road aforesaid opposite to the opening between the houses situate upon the eastern side of the last-named road and called or known as Adair Cottage and Oak Lodge being 219 and 221 Balham High-road respectively and extending thence southward along the middle of the said last-named road for a distance of four chains or thereabouts to its junction with Ritherdon-road and extending thence eastward along the

middle of the last-named road for a distance of fifteen and a half chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said new parish of Upper Tooting from the new parish of Saint Mary Streatham aforesaid.

"The SECOND SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the said new parish of Upper Tooting and to be annexed to the new parish (sometime consolidated chapelry) of the Ascension Balham Hill in the said county of Surrey and in the diocese of Rochester aforesaid being:—

"All that portion of the said new parish of Upper Tooting which is bounded upon the east partly by the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham and partly by the new parish of the Ascension Balham Hill aforesaid upon the north-west and upon the west by the parish of Battersea aforesaid and upon the remaining side that is to say, upon the south-west by an imaginary line commencing at the point at or near to the south-east corner of Wandsworth Common as aforesaid in the middle of the line of the said London Brighton and South Coast Railway where the boundary dividing the said parish of Battersea from the consolidated chapelry of Saint Mary Magdalene Wandsworth Common joins the boundary dividing the last-named cure from the new parish of Upper Tooting aforesaid and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of the same line of railway for a distance of ten chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said new parish of Upper Tooting from the new parish of Saint Mary Streatham aforesaid.

"The THIRD SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be annexed to the said new parish of Upper Tooting, being:—

"I. All that portion of the parish of Battersea aforesaid lying generally upon the eastern sides of Saint James's-road and of Trinity-road which for all ecclesiastical purposes has become isolated from the main portion of the said parish of Battersea and is bounded upon all sides, as follows, that is to say, upon the north and upon the west by the consolidated chapelry of Saint Mary Magdalene Wandsworth Common aforesaid upon the south-west partly by the last-named consolidated chapelry and partly by the herein-after-described portion of the parish of Saint Anne Wandsworth in the county and diocese aforesaid, and upon the south-east and upon the east by the new parish of Upper Tooting aforesaid.

"II. And also all that portion of the said parish of Saint Anne Wandsworth which is situate upon the southern side of Crockerton-road and which is bounded upon the south-east by the said new parish of Upper Tooting upon the north-east by the above-described portion of the parish of Battersea upon the north-west by the consolidated chapelry of Saint Mary Magdalene Wandsworth Common and upon the remaining side that is to say upon the south-west by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said consolidated chapelry of Saint Mary Magdalene Wandsworth Common from the parish of Saint Anne Wandsworth aforesaid at the junction of Crockerton-road aforesaid with Beechcroft-road and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of two chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said parish of Saint Anne Wandsworth from the new parish of Upper Tooting aforesaid.

"III. And also all that portion of the said new parish of Saint Mary Streatham which is bounded upon the south by the parish of Saint Nicholas
