And if after the 30th day of this suffant mench of May any Arms or Ammunition shall be found upon the Person, or in the possession of any such bish Papists, he and they shall be looked upon as Rebeis, and Punished accordingly. And as They retend inversely to Punish all such as shall offend in any of the Pariculars above-mentioned so They do assert of the Particulars above-mentioned, so They do affure all those Iris's Papists who live under Their Majesties Protection, That they, behaving themselves as becometh good Subjects, shall have the Benefit thereof.
